a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadieville*
in the County of *Kent*

in Our Province

of New Brunswick and bounded as follows to-wit:—

Beginning at a stake standing on the eastern side of a reserved road which adjoins easterly the Intercolonial Railway and reservation, at the south west angle of lot number one hundred and seventeen granted to J Nelson Price north of the Nouvelle-Bourgeoisie River, thence running by the magnet South eighty seven degrees East sixty two chains; thence South three degrees West, ten chains and fifty links; thence North eighty seven degrees West sixty chains to a juniper tree standing on the eastern side of the aforesaid reserved road and thence along the same, following the course thereof, ten chains and eighty links to the place of beginning

Containing sixty four acres, more or less and distinguished as lot number one hundred and sixteen North, north of Nouvelle-Bourgeoisie River

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

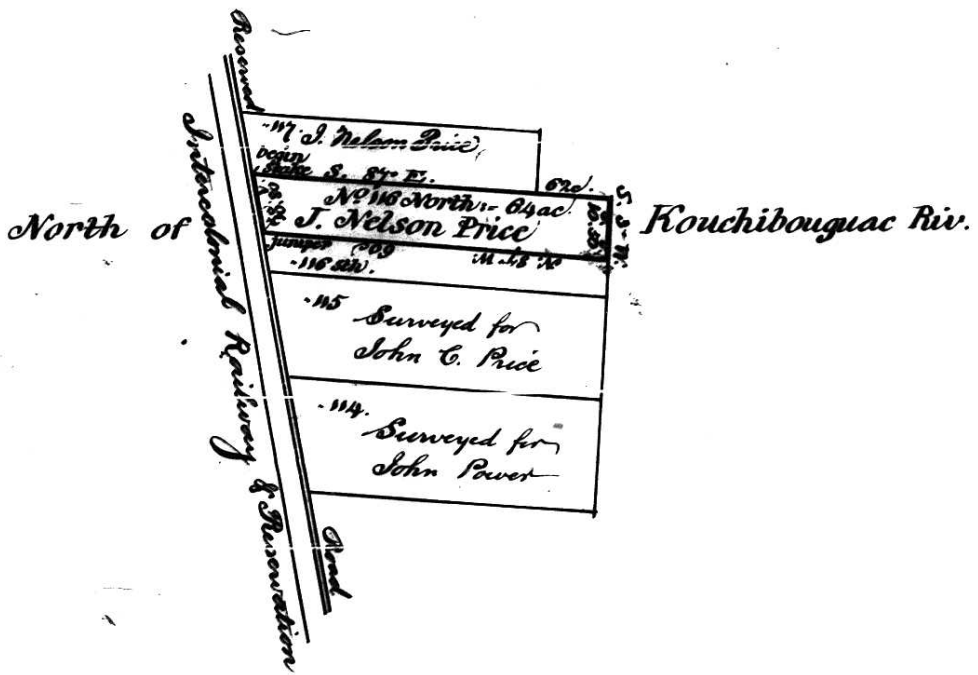
