KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Oliver Burk his*

Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*

in the County of *Northumberland*

in Our Province

of New Brunswick and bounded as follows to-wit:

*Beginning at a Stake standing on the eastern side of a reserved road at the most western angle of lot number eighty eight granted to Joe Breen in the Pleasant Ridge Settlement West of Intercolonial Railway thea running by the angle south forty five degrees east fifty five chains and sixty links thence south eighteen degrees west twenty chains thence north forty five degrees west fifty five chains and sixty links to the eastern side of the aforesaid reserved road and thence along the same north eighteen degrees east twenty chains to the place of beginning, Containing One hundred Acres more or less and distinguished as lot number eighty nine in the Pleasant Ridge Settlement West of Intercolonial Railway*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said
