QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Francis Burke his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*
in the County of *Northumberland* in Our Province

of New Brunswick and bounded as follows to-wit:—

Beginning at a stake standing on the western side of a reserved road at the most eastern angle of lot number sixty four granted to Deslime Herbert in the Pleasant Ridge Settlement, thence running by the magnet north forty five degrees west fifty two Chains thence north sixty degrees east forty Chains and fifty links thence south one degree east fifty eight Chains to the place of beginning. Containing one Hundred acres more or less and distinguished as the west half of lot number seventy three in the Pleasant Ridge Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

Francis Burke his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
