**Victoria**, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,  
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Thomas Harnett his* Heirs and Assigns,  
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogersville*  
in the County of *Northumberland* in Our Province  
of New Brunswick and bounded as follows to-wit:—

*Beginning at a stake standing on the western side of the Intercolonial Railway and reservation at the south east angle of lot number sixteen granted to James Harnett in the Barnaby River Settlement, thence running by the margin along the said Railway and reservation south seven degrees and fifteen minutes east eleven chains to a spruce tree, thence south eighty nine degrees and fifteen minutes west fifty chains to a cedar tree thence south seven degrees and fifteen minutes east twelve chains to a pine tree, thence south eighty nine degrees and fifteen minutes west twenty three chains to a stake thence north seven degrees and fifteen minutes west twenty three chains to a spruce tree, thence north eighty nine degrees and fifteen minutes east seventy three chains to the place of beginning. Containing one hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number ninety five Southerly and adjoining the Barnaby River Settlement*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

*Thomas Harnett his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
