**Victoria**, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,  
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Wilfred & Richard his* Heirs and Assigns,  
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadville*  
in the County of *Kent* in Our Province

of New Brunswick and bounded as follows to-wit:—*Beginning on the Southern bank or shore of the Kouchibouguac River at the southeast angle of lot number One hundred and one granted to Jacques & Breau west of Intercolonial Railway thence running by the magnet south three degrees and fifteen minutes west seventy Chains to a spruce tree thence south eighty six degrees and forty five minutes east fifteen Chains and fifty links to a stake standing on the western side of a reserved road which adjoins on the western side of the Intercolonial Railway and Reservation thence along the said reserved road north three degrees and fifteen minutes east sixty Chains to the southern bank or shore of the Kouchibouguac River aforesaid and thence along the same following the several courses thereof up stream in a westerly direction to the place beginning containing One Hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number one hundred*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

*Wilfred & Richard his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

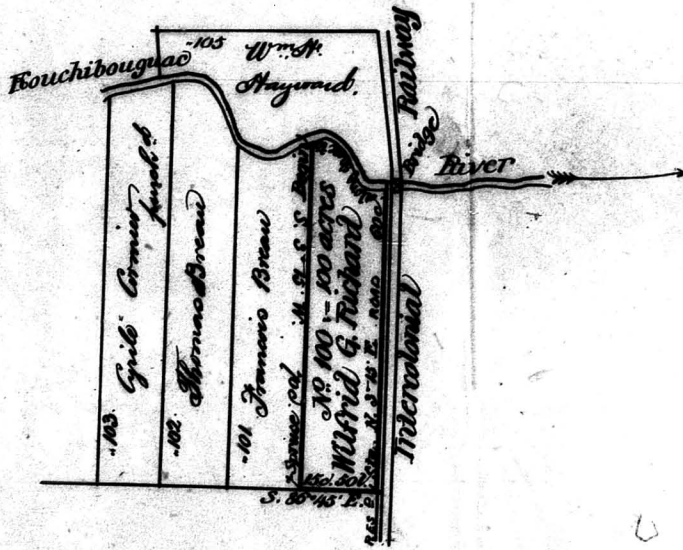
