R. D. Wilmot **Victoria**, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Pacificus A. Arsenau his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*
in the County of *Northumberland* in Our Province

of New Brunswick and bounded as follows to-wit:— *Beginning at a stake*

standing on the south eastern side of the settlement road at the most western angle of lot number eighteen granted to Ambrose Arsano in Rogerville Settlement thence running by the magnet south forty degrees east two Chains to another stake, thence south forty degrees west fifteen Chains and twenty links, thence north forty degrees west thirteen Chains to another stake standing on the south eastern side of the aforesaid Settlement road and thence along the same north fifty degrees east each fifteen Chains to the place of beginning containing Seventeen acres more or less and distinguished as lot number seventeen and one half in the Rogerville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

Pacificus A. Arsenau his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

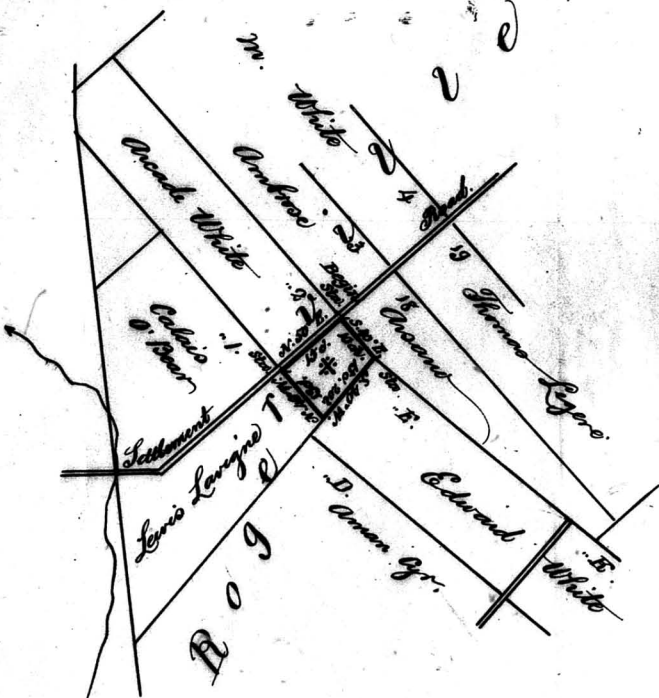
