QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, *Greeting* :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

David Collet his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*

in the County of *Northumberland* in Our Province

of New Brunswick and bounded as follows to-wit:—

Beginning at a fir tree standing on the southern side of the Settlement road at the north west angle of lot number Seventy eight in the Collet Settlement thence running by the magnet South twenty degrees east sixty seven Chains thence South seventy degrees West four Chains thence South forty five degrees West twelve Chains thence North twenty degrees West seventy one Chains and fifty links to a hemlock tree standing on the southern side of the aforesaid Settlement road and thence along the same North seventy degrees East fifteen Chains to the place of beginning containing One Hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number Seventy seven in the Collet Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, and all hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

David Collet his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

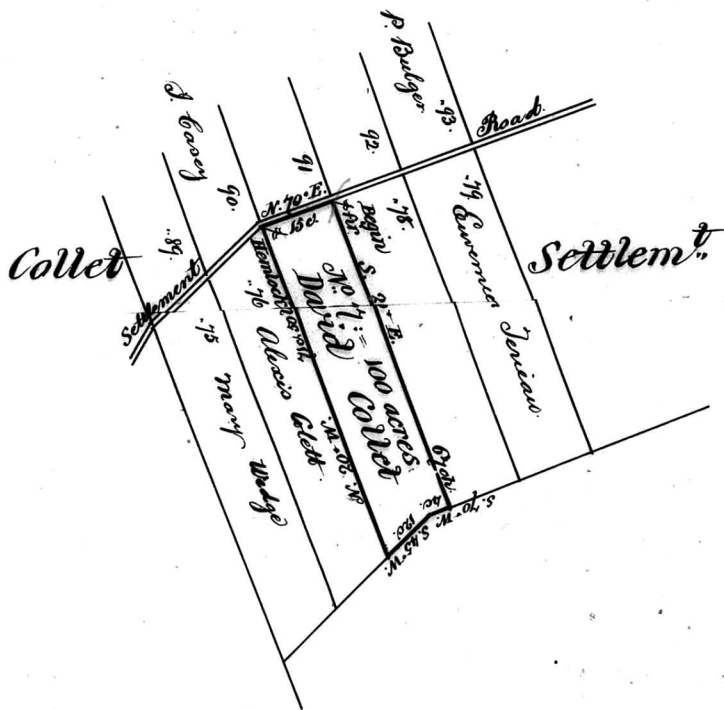
