KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Chrisostome Legere his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*
in the County of *Northumberland* in Our Province

of New Brunswick and bounded as follows to wit:—

Regumungata
Spruce tree standing on the northern side
of a reserved road at the south east angle of
lot number One Hundred and seven in the
northeast Rogerville Settlement thence running
by the magnet north sixty seven Chains
thence east six Chains to a stake thence north
sixty five degrees east ten Chains thence South
Seventy Chains to another spruce tree standing
on the north west side of the aforesaid reserved
road and thence along the same West fifteen
Chains to the place of beginning containing
One Hundred acres more or less and distinguished
as lot number One Hundred and eight in the
northeast Rogerville Settlement.

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

Chrisostome Legere his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
