KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Daddy Gould his

Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadiville*
in the County of *Hent*

in Our Province

of New Brunswick and bounded as follows to-wit:—

Beginning at a stake standing on the northern side of a reserved road at the south east angle of lot number one hundred and twenty two granted to George Gould in the Third Tier of Acadiville Settlement thence running by the magnetic north three degrees east eighty Chains to another stake thence south eighty seven degrees east twelve Chains and fifty links to a spruce tree, thence south three degrees west eighty Chains to another stake standing on the northern side of the aforesaid reserved road, and thence along the same north eighty seven degrees west twelve Chains and fifty links to the place of beginning. Containing One Hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number One Hundred and twenty three in the Third Tier of Acadiville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

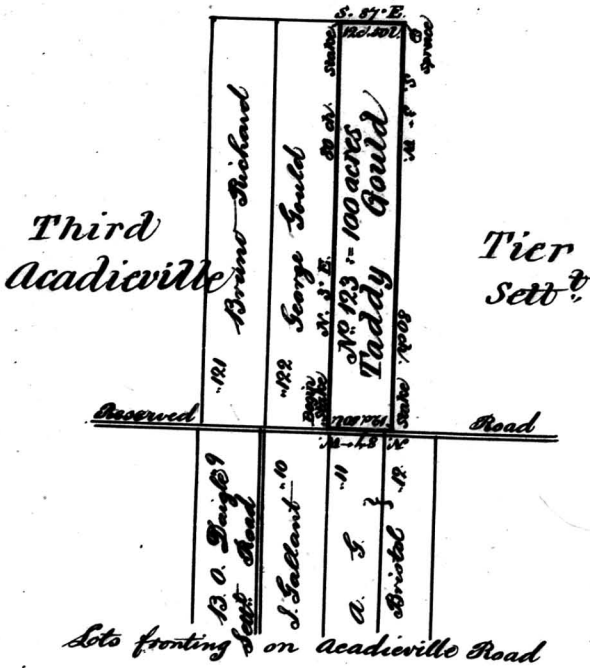
