QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, *Greeting* :

KNOW YE, That We, of Our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents, for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Napoleon Moisson his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*
in the County of *Northumberland* in Our Province

of New Brunswick and bounded as follows to-wit:— *Beginning at a birch*

tree standing on the north western side of the Settlement road, at the most eastern angle of lot number eighty seven granted to Sedy McEwan in the Collet Settlement, thence running by the magnetic along the said Settlement road north thirty degrees east fifteen Chains to a spruce tree thence north twenty degrees West twenty two Chains thence south forty five degrees West eight chains and fifty links to a stake, thence south one degree east ten Chains and thence south twenty degrees east sixty eight Chains to the place of beginning containing Eighty acres more or less and distinguished as lot number eighty eight in the Collet Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land, and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

Napoleon Moisson his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be registered in the Secretary's Office of Our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a Duplicate of the Plan herunto annexed.

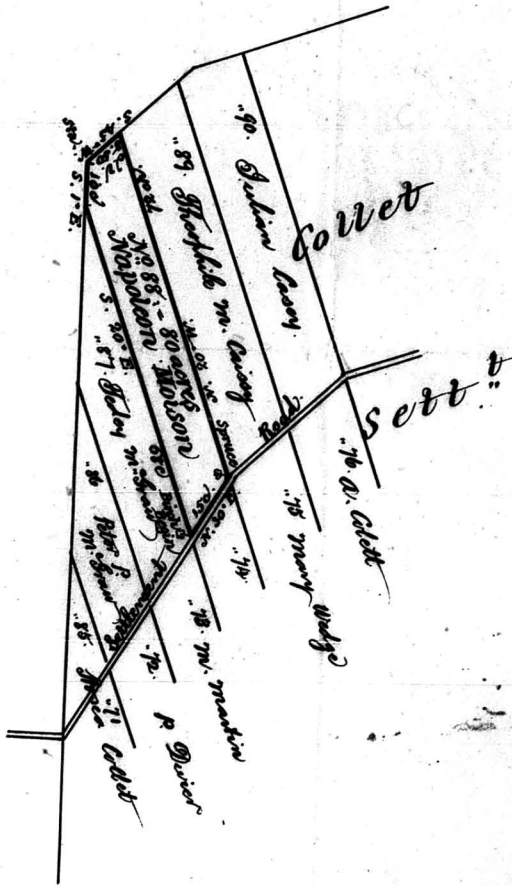
