Tract of Land situate in the Parish of

in the County of

Northumberland

in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

*Beginning at a
birch tree standing on the northern side of a
reserved road at the south west angle of lot
number thirty nine in the Barnaby River
Settlement West of Intercolonial Railway
thence running by the magnet along the said
reserved road south eighty nine degrees West
twenty Chains to a stake thence north one
degree West fifty Chains to another stake
thence north eighty nine degrees East twenty Chains
and thence south one degree East fifty Chains
to the place of beginning, containing One
Hundred Acres more or less and distinguished
as lot number forty in the Barnaby River
Settlement, West of Intercolonial Railway*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except
and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold
and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land
