in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:— *Beginning at a*

*Spruce tree standing on the northern side of
a cleared road at the south east angle of lot
number One Hundred and eight granted to
Chas. Stone Legos in the north east Rogersville
Settlement, thence running by the Magnet
north twenty Chains, thence north sixty
five degrees, east fifteen Chains and fifty links
thence south twenty Chains to another spruce
tree standing on the northern side of the afore said
cleared road, and thence along the same South
Sixty five degrees, west fifteen Chains and fifty
links to the place of beginning - Containing
One Hundred acres more or less and
distinguished as lot number One hundred
and nine in the north east Rogersville
Settlement*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
