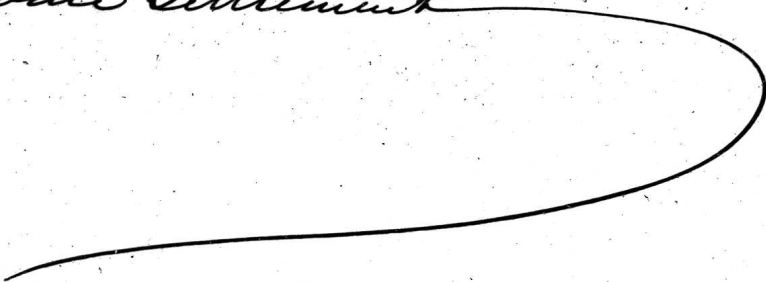
Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Glewy*
