Tract of Land situate in the Parish of

in the County of

Northumberland

in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a

maple tree standing on the northern side of a reserved road at the southeast angle of lot number thirty nine granted to James Gillies in the Barnaby River Settlement, west of Intercolonial Railway, thence running by the magnet north one degree west fifty Chains thence south eighty nine degrees east twenty Chains thence south one degree East fifty Chains to a stake standing on the northern side of the aforesaid reserved road, and thence along the same south eighty nine degrees west twenty Chains to the place of beginning containing One Hundred acres more or less and designated as lot number thirty eight in the Barnaby River Settlement, west of Intercolonial Railway

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said

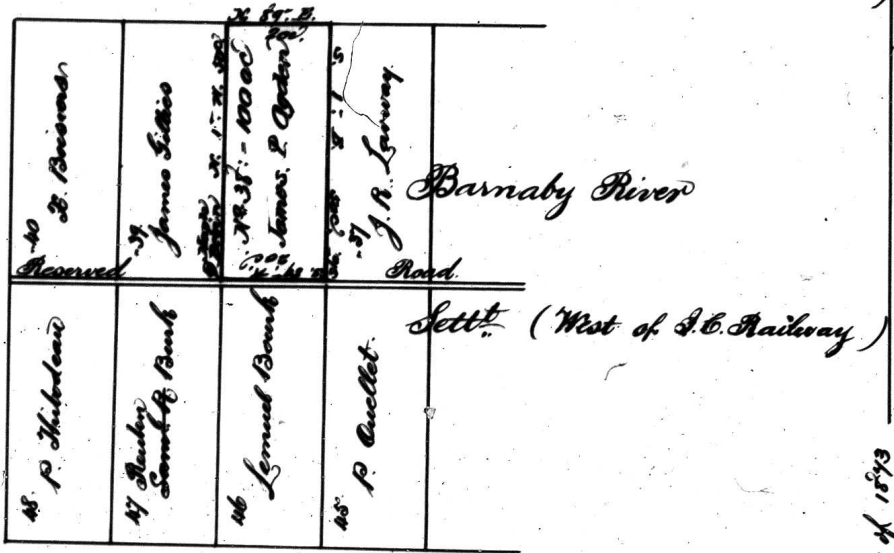
