in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a stump standing on the southern side of the settlement road at the northwest angle of lot number forty nine granted to Maximie Richard in the south east Rogeriville Settlement thence running by the magnetic south twenty degrees west eighty Chains to a stake thence north seventy degrees west twelve Chains and fifty links to a spruce tree thence north twenty degrees east eighty Chains to another stake standing on the southern side of the aforesaid settlement road and thence along the same south seventy degrees east twelve Chains and fifty links to the place of beginning containing one hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number forty eight in the south east Rogeriville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said

Damien Richard his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.
