KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Dosite Hachey his
Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*
in the County of *Northumberland*

Heirs and Assigns,

in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit:—

Beginning at a Cedar tree standing on the northern side of, a settlement road at the southeast angle of lot number One Hundred and six granted to Eugene Legre in the northeast Rogerville Settlement, thence running by the magnet north sixty seven Chains thence east fifteen Chains thence south sixty seven Chains to a spruce tree standing on the northern side of the Settlement Road aforesaid and thence along the same West fifteen Chains to the place of beginning containing One Hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number One Hundred and seven in the North East Rogerville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said *Dosite Hachey his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

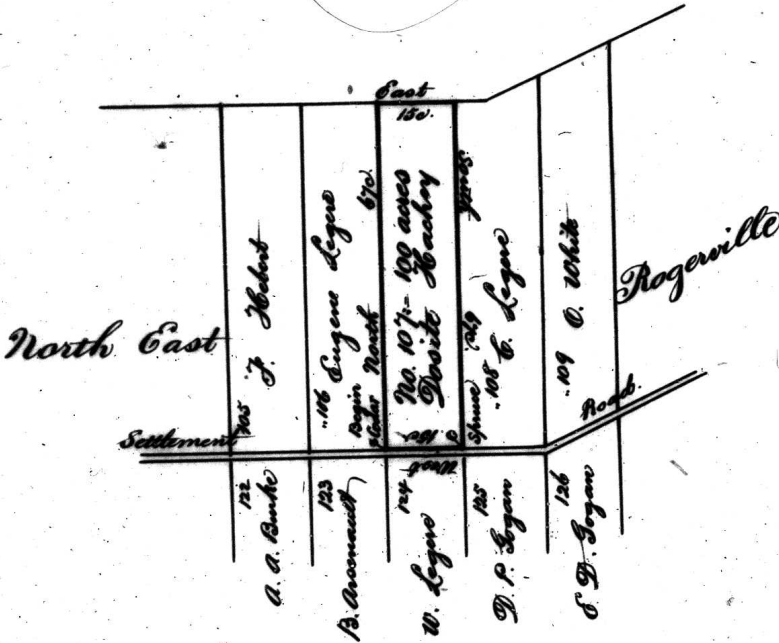
