VICTORIA, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
Queen, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given
and granted, and We do by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto
Gustave Gallin his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Pingville*
in the County of *Northumberland* in our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Beginning at a spruce tree
standing on the southern side of the Settlement Road at the north
east angle of lot number eighty three granted to Urban G. Gallin
in the Collet Settlement, thence running by the magnet along the
said Settlement Road North seventy degrees East fifteen chains
to another spruce tree thence south twenty degrees East sixty seven
chains to a stake thence south seventy degrees West fifteen chains
and thence North twenty degrees West sixty seven chains to the place
of beginning, containing One hundred acres more or less and distinguished
as lot number eighty four in the Collet Settlement.

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except
and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold
and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *Tract* of Land
and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said
Gustave Gallin his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's
Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto
annexed.
