**VICTORIA**, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,  
Queen, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING :

KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given  
and granted, and We do by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*John McLeod his* Heirs and Assigns,

Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadewille*  
in the County of *Kent* in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

*Beginning at a post standing on the western side of a reserved road, which adjoins westerly the Intercolonial Railway Reservation at the north east angle of Lot number One Hundred and sixteen granted to George McLeod North of Kouchibouguac River thence running by the Magnet south eight two degrees and thirty minutes West forty chains thence North One degree and thirty minutes east eleven Chains to the Southern side of another reserved road, thence along the same north eight two degrees and thirty minutes east thirty eight chains and fifty links to the Western side of the first aforesaid reserved road thence along the same south seven degrees and thirty minutes east eleven Chains to the place of beginning containing forty four acres more or less and distinguished as lot number one hundred and Seventeen, north of Kouchibouguac River*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said *John McLeod his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

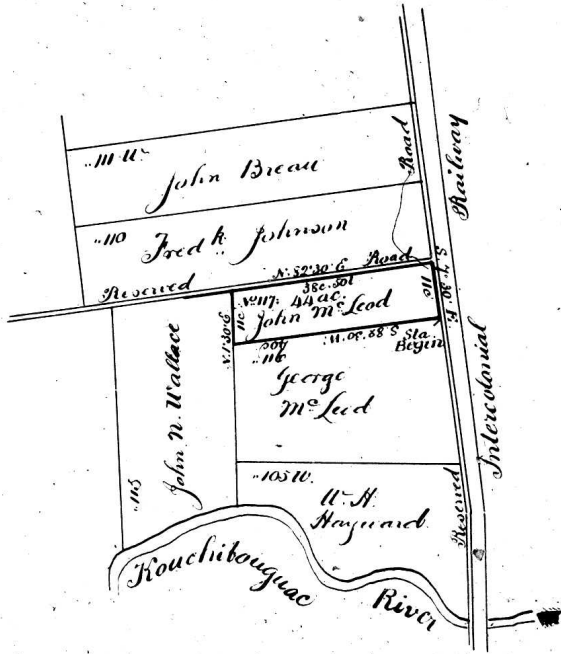
