Queen, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given
and granted, and We do by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Alex. Gallant his Heirs and Assigns,

Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadewille*
in the County of *Kent* in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

*Beginning at a
Spruce tree standing on the northern side of the
Settlement Road at the south east angle of lot
number three granted to Oliver J. Richard
in the Acadewille Settlement. Thence running
by the Magnet north three degrees and thirty
minutes east eighty Chains thence south eighty
Six degrees and thirty minutes east twelve chains
and fifty links. thence south three degrees and
thirty minutes West eighty Chains to a fir tree
standing on the northern side of the Settlement
Road aforesaid and thence along the same
north, eighty six degrees and thirty minutes
West twelve Chains and fifty links to the
place of beginning. Containing one Hundred
Acres more or less and distinguished as lot
number four in the Acadewille Settlement*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except
and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold
and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land
and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted) unto the said

Alex. Gallant his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto
annexed.

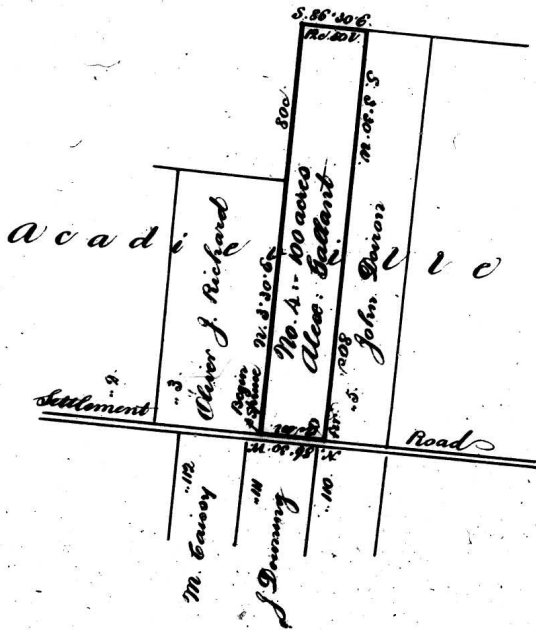
