Beginning at a stake standing at the north west angle of Lot letter K. granted to Charles Hillel on the northern side of Mouchibougua River thence running by the magnetic north eighty six degrees and twenty minutes West ninety seven Chains and fifty links to another stake standing on the eastern side of the Settlement Road thence along the same north three degrees and fifteen minutes East ten Chains and twenty links to a spruce tree standing on the Southern side of the Settlement Road aforesaid thence along the same south eighty six degrees and forty five minutes East ninety seven Chains and fifty links to another stake and thence South three degrees and fifteen minutes West ten Chains and twenty links to the place of beginning. Containing One hundred acres more or less, and distinguished as Lot ^{after} K. North of Mouchibougua River

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land

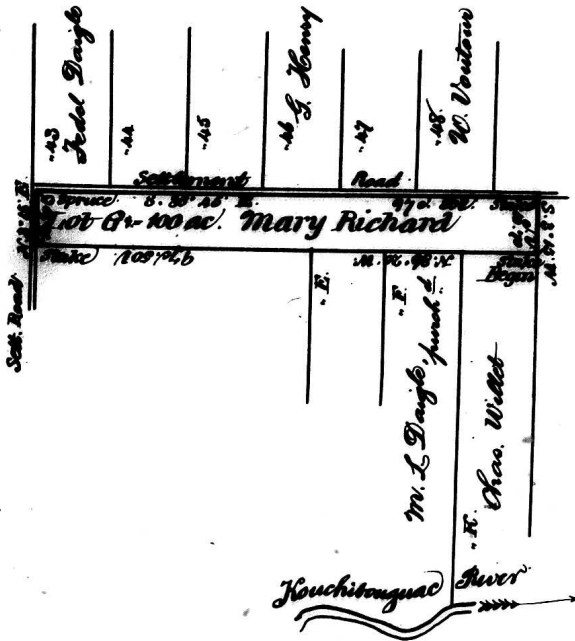
