KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Joseph Voutour his* Heirs and Assigns,

Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadewille*

in the County of

*Kent*

in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

*Beginning at a stake standing on the southern side of a reserved road at the northeast angle of lot number two hundred and one granted to Marcel Henri in the Acadewille Settlement thence running by the Magnet along the said reserved road South sixty nine degrees and fifteen minutes east twenty seven Chains to another stake thence South <sup>thirty</sup> degrees and thirty minutes west twenty nine Chains and sixty links to another stake thence north eighty six degrees and thirty minutes west twenty six Chains and twenty links to another stake and thence north three degrees and thirty minutes east thirty six Chains to the place of beginning Containing Eighty six acres more or less and distinguished as Lot number two hundred and two in the Acadewille Settlement*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said *Joseph Voutour his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.
