KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Esote L Barault his* Heirs and Assigns,

Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadewille*

in the County of *Herk*

in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

*Beginning at a stake standing on the westward side of the Settlement Road, at the northeast angle of Lot number one hundred and twenty two purchased by Sebastian D'outour in the Richard Settlement, thence running by the magnet north sixty nine degrees and thirty minutes west eighty Chains to another stake thence north twenty degrees and thirty minutes east twelve Chains and fifty links to another stake thence south sixty nine degrees and thirty minutes east eighty Chains to another stake standing on the Westward side of the Settlement road aforesaid and thence along the same south twenty degrees and thirty minutes west twelve Chains and fifty links to the place of beginning Containing One Hundred acres more or less, and distinguished as of number one hundred and twenty three in the Richard Settlement*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said *Esote L Barault his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER. PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
