Queen, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and
granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Odilon Poirier, his Heirs and Assigns,

Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*
in the County of *Northumberland* in our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

*Beginning at a
fir tree standing on the northern side of the
Settlement road at the south east angle of Lot
number one hundred and one granted to
Calice Caissy, in the north east Rogerville
Settlement thence running by the magnetic
north sixty seven Chains thence east fifteen
Chains thence south sixty seven Chains to another
fir tree standing on the northern side of the
aforesaid Settlement road, and thence along the
same West fifteen Chains to the place of beginning
Containing One hundred acres more or less
and distinguished as Lot number one hundred
and two in the Northeast Rogerville Settlement*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except
and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals; and also all Gold and
Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land
and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said
Odilon Poirier, his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's
Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto
annexed.
