VICTORIA, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto *Dorothea Voutour,* *his* Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadieville*

in the County of *Kent.*

in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Beginning at a Stake standing on the Eastern side of a reserved road, at the South Western angle of Lot letter A, granted to Paul Pabrean, in the Acadieville Settlement, Thence running by the magnet South eighty-six degrees and thirty minutes East fifty-seven chains, Thence South three degrees and thirty minutes West sixteen chains and seventy links to a Pine tree, standing on the Northern side of another reserved road, and thence along the same North eighty-six degrees and thirty minutes West fifty-seven chains to a Spruce tree, standing on the Eastern side of the first aforesaid reserved road, and thence along the same North three degrees and thirty minutes East sixteen chains and seventy links to the place of beginning, Containing Ninety-five acres, more or less, and distinguished as Lot number Fifty-Nine, in the Acadieville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said *Dorothea Voutour,* *his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
