KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto Joseph Moullet, his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of Acadieville  
in the County of Kent.

in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:— Beginning at a Stake

standing on the Western side of the Settlement Road, at the North East angle of Lot number One hundred and Seventy-four, purchased by Narcisse L. Parriault in the Richard Settlement, thence running by the aforesaid North sixty-nine degrees and Thirty minutes West Sixty-seven chains to another stake, thence North twenty degrees and Thirty minutes East fifteen chains thence South Sixty-nine degrees and Thirty minutes East Sixty-seven chains to another stake standing on the Western side of the aforesaid Settlement Road, and thence along the same South twenty degrees and Thirty minutes West fifteen chains to the place of beginning.

Containing One hundred acres, more or less, and distinguished as Lot number One, in the Richard Settlement.

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said
