VICTORIA, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,

Queen, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Amédé Chiasson, his Heirs and Assigns,

Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*
in the County of *Northumberland* in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Beginning at a stake standing at the northwest angle of Lot number One hundred and eighty two granted Jonas Pitus south of the Pleasant Ridge Settlement West of the Intercolonial Railway thence running by the maput south fifty minutes east sixty seven Chains to another stake thence south eighty nine degrees and ten minutes west fifteen Chains to a yellow birch tree thence north fifty minutes west sixty seven Chains to another stake and thence north eighty nine degrees and ten minutes east fifteen Chains to the place of beginning, Containing One hundred acres more or less, and distinguished as Lot number One hundred and eighty three south of the Pleasant Ridge Settlement West of the Intercolonial Railway

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

Amédé Chiasson, his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
