**VICTORIA**, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,  
Queen, Defender of the Faith, &c. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Sh. Dilley*  
*Celestine Robicheau his* Heirs and Assigns,  
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadville*  
in the County of *West* in our Province  
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

*Beginning at a  
Spoke standing at the south west angle of  
Lot number One hundred and fifty six surveyed  
for Job Robichaud in the third tier north of the  
North Branch of Mr. James Brook, thence running  
by the magnet south sixty nine degrees and  
thirty minutes west twenty Chains to another stake  
thence north twenty degrees and thirty minutes east  
fifty Chains to a spruce tree thence south sixty nine  
degrees and thirty minutes east twenty Chains  
to another spruce tree and thence south twenty  
degrees and thirty minutes west fifty Chains to the  
place of beginning Containing One hundred  
Acres more or less and distinguished as lot  
number One hundred and fifty eight in the  
Tier north of the north Branch of Mr. James Brook*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

*Celestine Robicheau his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

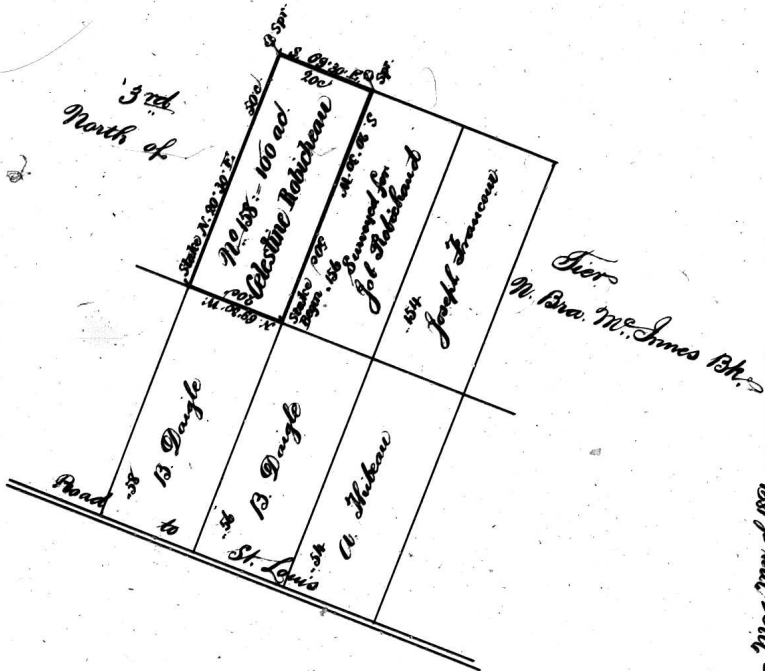
