KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

James Gueguen his Heirs and Assigns,

Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*
in the County of *Northumberland* in our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Beginning at a post standing at the north east angle of lot number One hundred and twenty six granted to Cyprien Logan in the Barnaby River Settlement thence running by the magnetic north eighty nine degrees east twenty Chains to another post thence south one degree east fifty Chains to another post thence south eighty nine degrees west twenty Chains to a stake and thence north one degree west fifty Chains to the place of beginning Containing One Hundred Acres more or less, and designated as lot number One hundred and twenty five in the Barnaby River Settlement.

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *Tract* of Land

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted), unto the said

James Gueguen his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

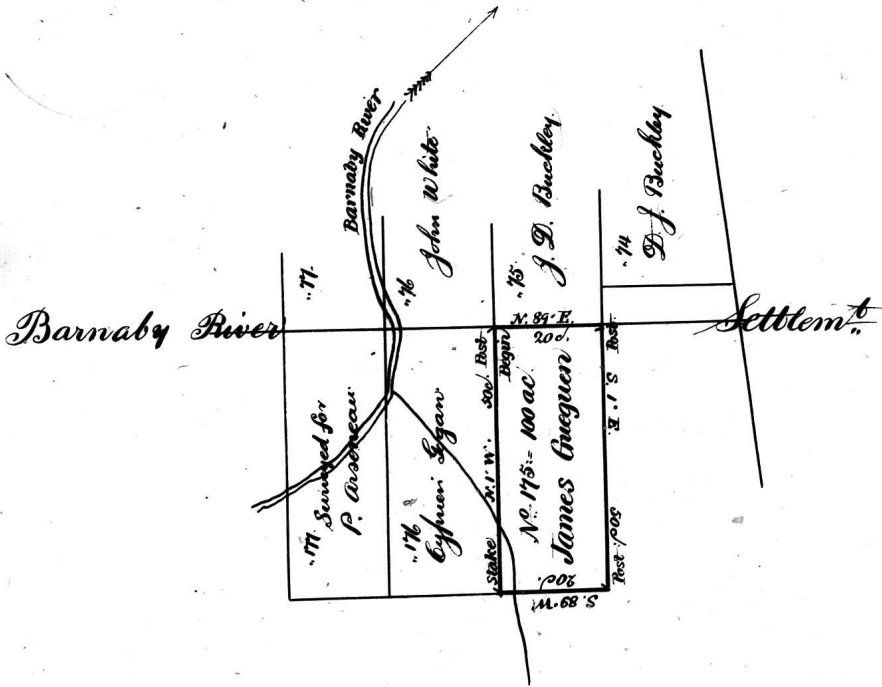
