of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:

*Beginning at a stake standing at the south east angle of lot number eighty two, granted to Urbain Porrier, in the Acadewille Settlement North of Kouchibouguac River thence running by the magnet north seventy degrees west fifty chains to another stake thence south twenty degrees west twenty chains to a spruce tree thence south seventy degrees east fifty chains to another stake and thence north twenty degrees east twenty chains to the place of beginning. Containing one hundred acres more or less and distinguished as Lot eighty four in the Acadewille Settlement North of Kouchibouguac River*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land

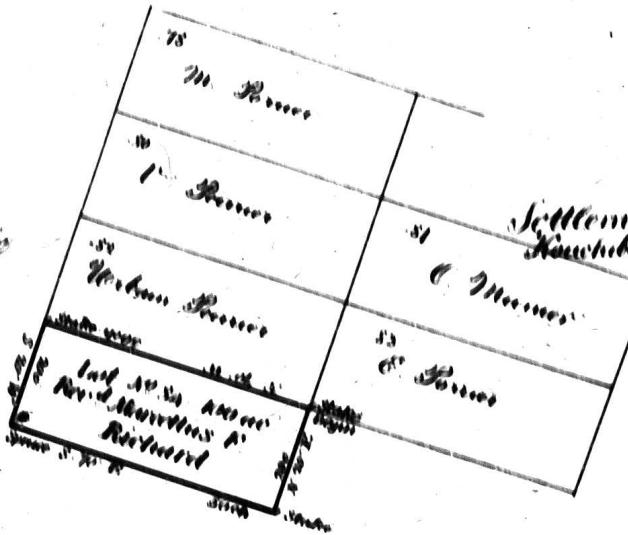
