stake standing on the northern side of a reserved road at the south west angle of lot number one hundred and twenty one granted to James Richard in Peer Three north of Kouchibouguac River in the Acadieville Settlement thence running by the said road north three degrees and twenty minutes east eighty chains then north eighty six degrees and thirty minutes west twelve chains and fifty links to another stake three south three degrees and twenty minutes west eighty chains or spruce tree standing on the northern side of the aforesaid reserved road and thence along the same south eighty six degrees and thirty minutes east twelve chains and fifty links to the place of beginning containing One hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot number one hundred and ten in the third Peer north of Kouchibouguac River in the Acadieville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coal, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land
