KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Pierre Blanchard His Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadieville*

in the County of *Kent* in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit: *Beginning at a*

Stake standing on the north side of a reserved road at the south west angle of Lot number one hundred and twenty one granted to Bruno Richard in Tier Three north of Kouchibouguac River in the Acadieville Settlement thence running by the magnetic north three degrees and twenty minutes east eighty chains thence north eighty six degrees and thirty minutes west twelve chains and fifty links to another stake thence south three degrees and twenty minutes west eighty chains to a spruce tree standing on the northern side of the aforesaid reserved road, and thence along the same south eighty six degrees and thirty minutes east twelve chains and fifty links to the place of beginning containing One hundred acres more or less, and distinguished as Lot number one hundred and two in the Third Tier north of Kouchibouguac River in the Acadieville Settlement

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey herunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted,) unto the said *Pierre Blanchard* His Heirs and Assigns, *son avn.*

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan herunto annexed.

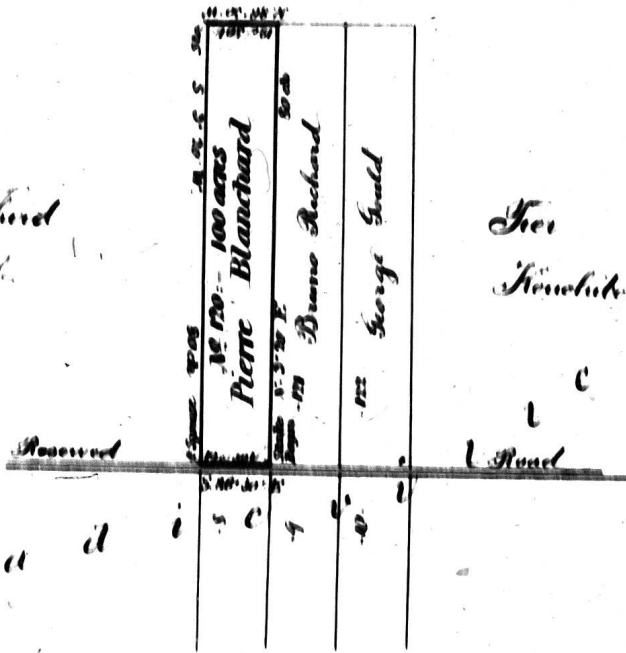
