Defender of the Faith, etc. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

And In Witness
KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Alexis V. Le Blanc his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadewille*
in the County of *Kent* in our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Beginning at a
Sycamore tree standing on the eastern side
of the Intercolonial Railway, Reservation and
measured along the said Railway and Reservation
in a westerly direction forty five Chains from a pine
tree standing at the north west angle of lot
number One hundred and eleven granted to
George Perry North of Kouchibouguac River the same
returning by the magnet from the aforesaid
Sycamore tree, south, eighty seven degrees east fifty
Chains to a spruce tree thence north three degrees
east, ninety Chains to a stake thence north
eighty seven degrees west fifty five Chains to
another stake standing on the eastern side
of the Intercolonial Railway and Reservation
aforesaid, and thence along the same in a
southerly direction to the place of beginning
Containing One hundred acres more or
less and distinguished as lot number
One hundred and fourteen on the eastern
side of the Intercolonial Railway North of
Kouchibouguac River

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted,) unto the said *Alexis V. Le Blanc* his Heirs and Assigns, *non solum* PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
