Beginning at a fir tree standing on the northern bank or shore of Kouchibouguac River at the south west angle of Lot Letter K granted to Charles Odell above M'Innis Brook, thence running by the magnet north thru degrees and forty minutes east seventy chains to a birch tree bearing north eight, six degrees and twenty minutes west from bearing chains and fifty links to a stake thence south three degrees and forty minutes west seventy two chains to the northern bank or shore of Kouchibouguac River aforesaid and thence along the same following the several Courses thereof down stream in an easterly direction to the place of beginning Containing One hundred acres more or less and distinguished as lot letter F on the northern side of Kouchibouguac River above M'Innis Brook

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted,) unto the said


