KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Odile LeBlanc his

Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadville*

in the County of *Rest*

in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Beginning at the south Western angle of Lot letter N, granted to Simon Henrie, the said angle being distant one Chain northward of the north Western bank or shore of Kouchibouguac River thence from the aforesaid angle and running by the magnet north three degrees and twenty minutes east forty four Chains to a post thence north eighty six degrees and forty minutes west seventeen Chains to another post thence south three degrees and twenty minutes west sixty seven Chains or to a point distant one Chain northward of the north Western bank or shore of Kouchibouguac River aforesaid and thence following parallel to the said bank or shore maintaining the distance of one Chain thence from in a northeasterly direction to the place of beginning. Excepting all that part of the Acadville road running through the above described tract, containing thirty four acres more or less and distinguished as lot letter M, north West of Kouchibouguac River above St Louis Brook

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted,) unto the said

Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

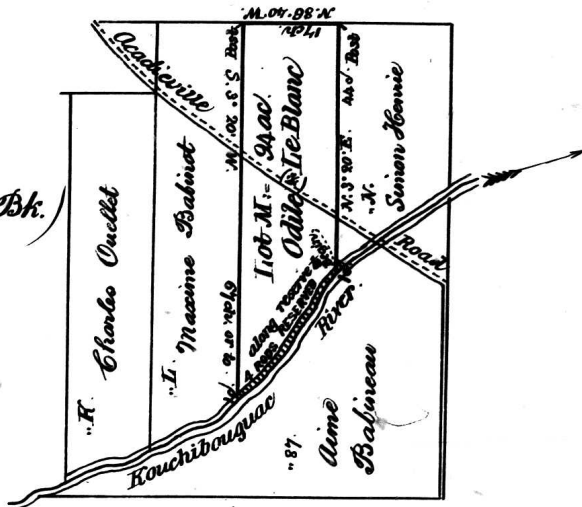
