A Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadewille*

in the County of *Acadewille*

in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Beginning at a pine stump standing at the south west angle of a one hundred acre lot granted to the Reverend M. F. Richard adjoining southerly of lots numbers 38, 39, 40 and 41, in the Acadewille settlement thence running by the magnet of the year 1894, South eighty six degrees and fifteen minutes east sixty Chains to a post, thence south three degrees and forty five minutes West sixteen Chains and seventy links to another post, thence north eighty six degrees and fifteen minutes West sixty Chains to another post and thence north three degrees and forty five minutes East sixteen Chains and seventy links to the place of beginning Containing one hundred acres more or less and distinguished as Lot number One hundred and thirty seven north of Konchouague River South of Acadewille Road

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed ; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining ; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals ; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land

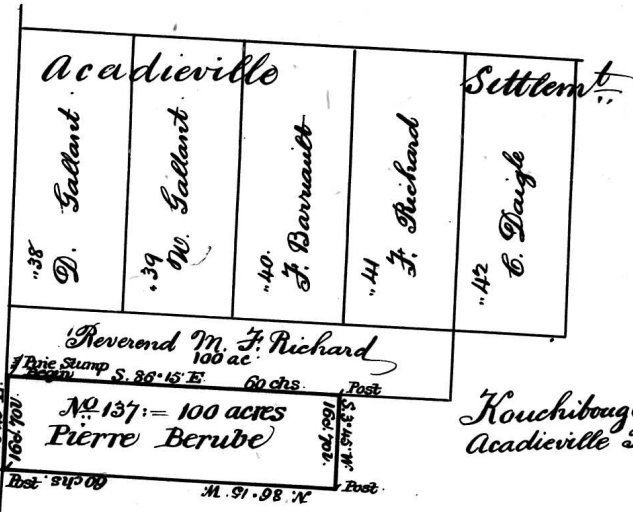
