Victoria, by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen,  
Defender of the Faith, etc. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Auguste LeBlond, his* Heirs and Assigns,

A Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Madame-Jeanne*  
in the County of *Restigouche* and in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

*standing on the western side of a surveyed road at the north eastern angle of a number since granted to Pierre B. Robitaille in an upward Settlement, thence running by the meand of the sea 100 north 20 west in degrees and thirty minutes west thirty chains, thence north 20 west 30 and thirty minutes east fifteen chains thence south 20 west in degrees and thirty minutes east sixty chains to another stake situate on the western side of the aforesaid surveyed road and thence along the same south 20 west degrees and thirty minutes west fifteen chains to the place beginning containing ninety acres, more or less, and distinguished as Lot number nine in the aforesaid Settlement.*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted,) unto the said *Auguste LeBlond, his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER. PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

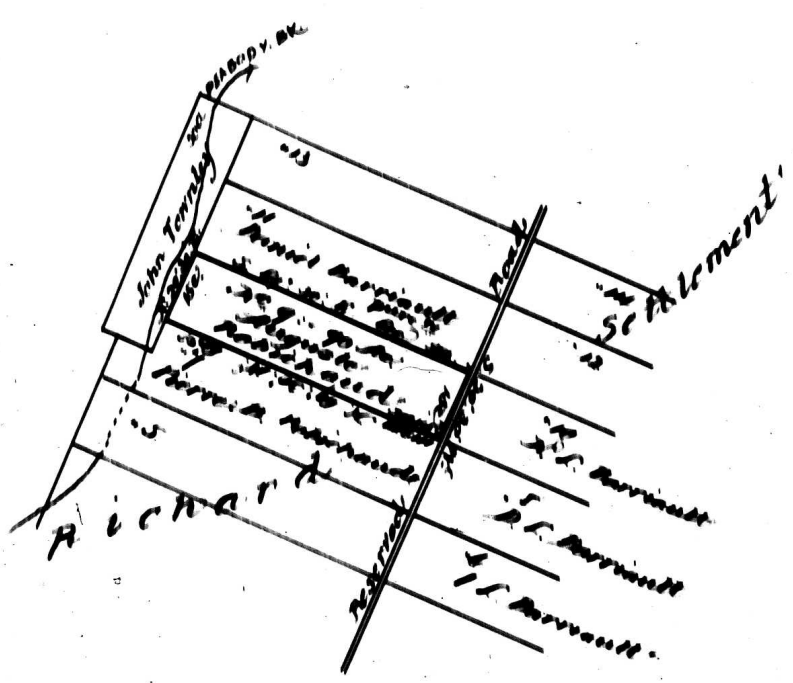
