KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Hortaulphe Savre his Heirs and Assigns,

Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Glenelg*

in the County of *Northumberland*

in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:—

Beginning at a stake standing on the eastern side of a reserved Road at the South West angle of Lot number Fifty two in Richard Settlement; thence running by the Magnet of the Year 1890 South Eighty Six degrees and Fifteen Minutes East forty chains and ninety links, thence South three degrees and Forty Five Minutes West Sixteen chains and Fifty links, thence North Eighty Six degrees and Fifteen Minutes East forty chains and ninety links to a stake standing on the Eastern side of the aforesaid Reserved Road and thence along the same North three degrees and forty five minutes East-Sixteen chains and Fifty links to the place of beginning.

Containing One Acre more or less and distinguished as Lot number Fifty in Richard Settlement.

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, (except before excepted,) unto the said *Hortaulphe Savre* his Heirs and Assigns, *son even*

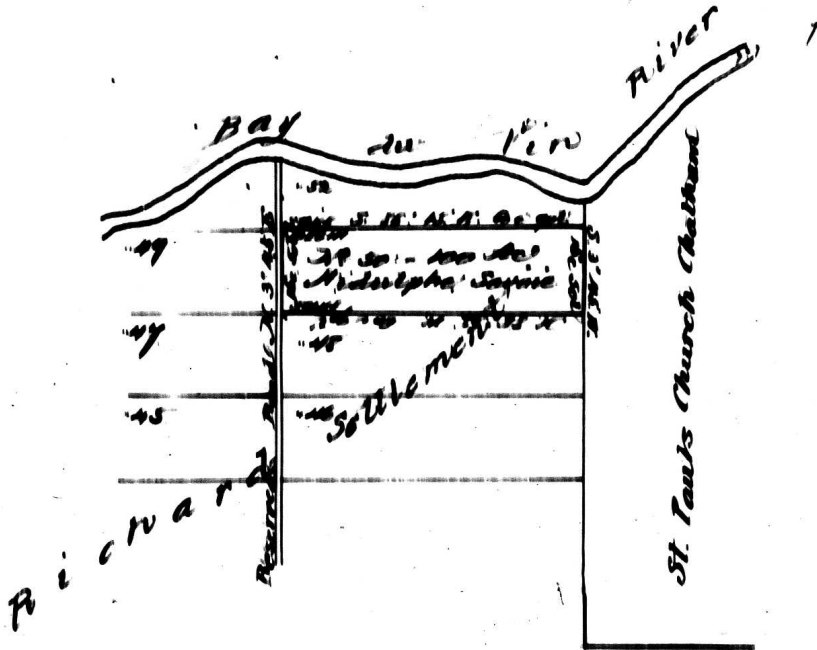
