and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

A Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadieville*,
in the County of *West* in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a stake standing on the Southern side of the settlement Road at the north west angle of Lot Number Sixty, thence by Oak Chavard, part of Denis Brook, thence running by the Cagnet of the year 1806. South four degrees, that fifty chains to another stake thence North eighty six degrees that twenty chains to another stake, thence North four degrees East fifty chains to another stake standing on the Southern side of the settlement Road aforesaid, and thence along the same, South eighty six degrees East twenty chains to the place of beginning.

Containing One Hundred acres more or less, and distinguished as Lot Number Sixty three, Denis Brook.

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *Tract* of Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances (except before excepted), unto the said

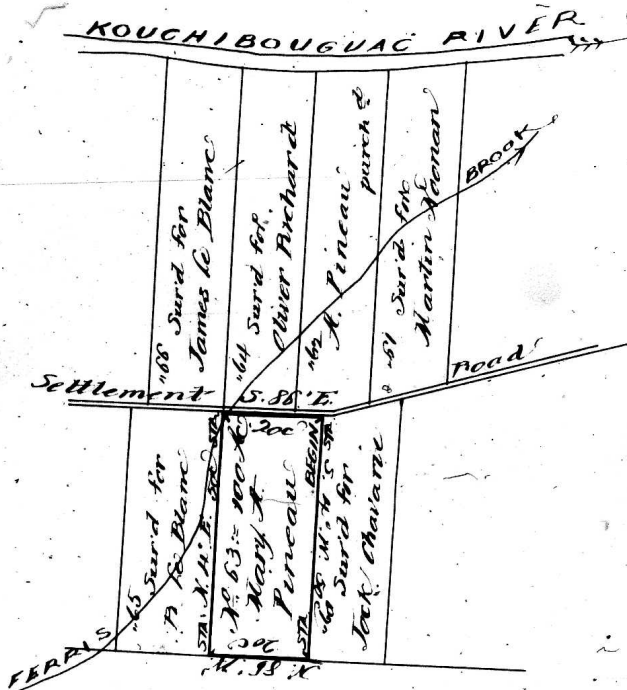
