Queen, Defender of the Faith, etc. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given  
and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Abdon Arseneault, his* Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadieville*

in the County of *Sent* in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:

*Beginning at a Point distant one chain on a course by the magnet of the year One Thousand Nine Hundred North three degrees and fifty minutes East, from a Post standing on the Northern bank or shore of Rouchibouguac River, and at the Southeastern angle of Lot Number Eighty-eight, granted to John Boutour thence from said Point North three degrees and fifty minutes East fifty nine chains to a Post standing on the Southern side of a Reserved Road, thence along the same South eighty six degrees and ten minutes East, twenty one chains to another Post, thence South three degrees and fifty minutes West thirty nine chains to a Point distant one chain on a course by the magnet North three degrees and fifty minutes East, from another Post, standing on the Northern bank or shore, of Rouchibouguac River aforesaid and thence in a South westerly direction and parallel to the said bank or shore reserving a distance of four rods therefrom to the place of beginning*

*Containing One Hundred acres, more or less, and distinguished as Lot Number Eighty-seven North of Rouchibouguac River, in Acadieville Settlement.*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances (except before excepted), unto the said

*Abdon Arseneault, his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

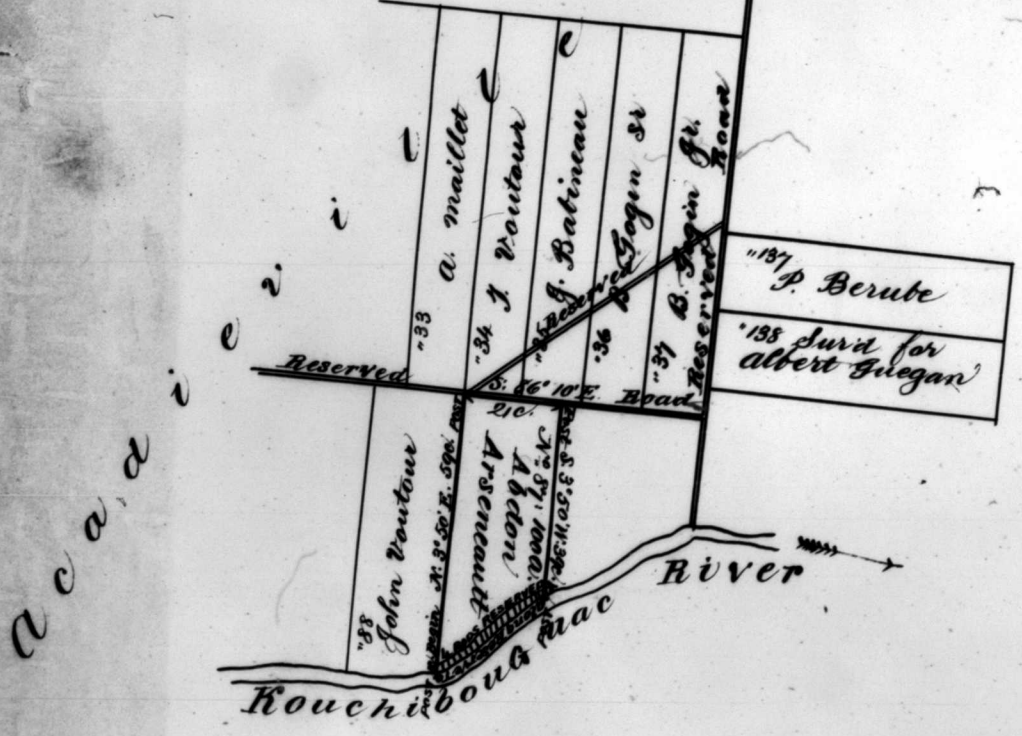
