KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*John E. Murray, his* Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadieville*  
in the County of *Sent* in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:

*Beginning at a Stake standing at the North-east angle of Lot Number One Hundred and Thirty-three granted to Jude Jc. Saucher, East of Intercolonial Railway; thence running by the Magnet of the year 1897 North forty nine degrees and thirty minutes West thirty five chains and fifteen links to the North-western side of the New Road from Rogerville to Acadieville; thence North forty degrees and thirty minutes East thirty-two chains, to another Stake; thence South forty nine degrees and thirty minutes East twenty-seven chains and eighty links to another Stake; thence North eighty-six degrees West twelve chains and fifty links to another Stake; and thence South four degrees West thirty chains and eighty links to the place of beginning. Excepting all that part of the New Road from Rogerville to Acadieville running through the above described Tract.*

*Containing Eighty-two Acres, more or less, and distinguished as Lot Number One Hundred and thirty-four East of Intercolonial Railway*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances (except before excepted), unto the said

*John E. Murray, his* Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

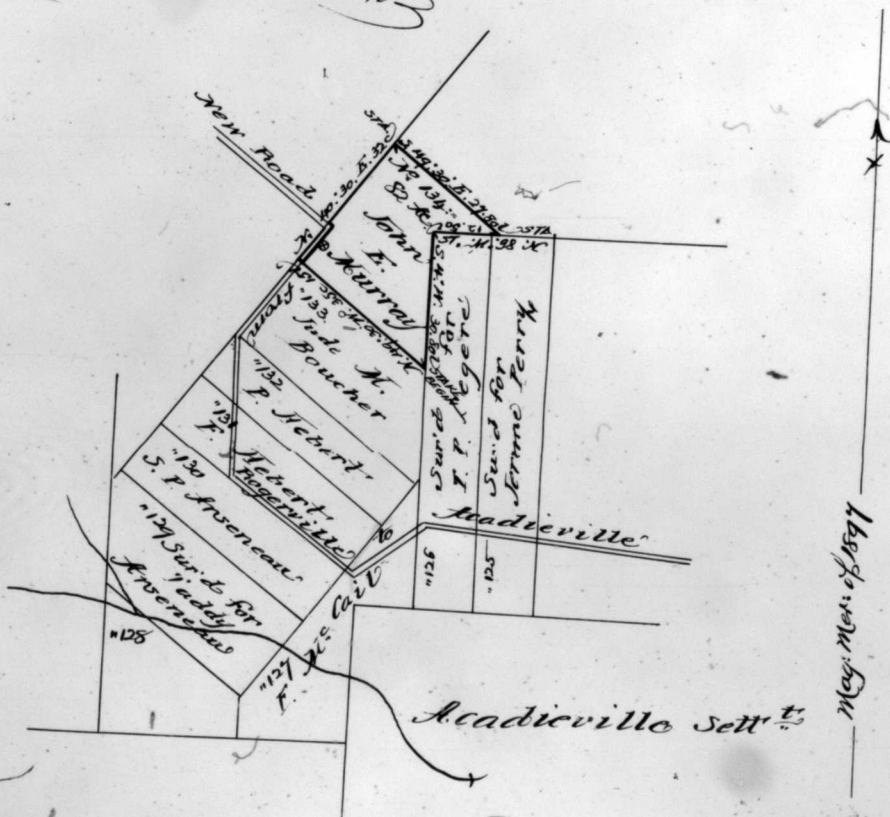
