Edward VII., by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
King, Defender of the Faith, etc. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:
KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given
and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto
Allan McLeod, his Heirs and Assigns,
a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadieville*
in the County of *Kent* in our Province
of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:

*Beginning at a stump
standing on the Western side of a Reserved Road which adjoins
the Intercolonial Railway and Reservation at the North-east
angle of Lot Number Ninety-nine granted to John Mc Donald
North of Rouchibouque River; thence running by the magnet of
the year 1879 South eighty-two degrees and thirty minutes West forty-
nine chains to a maple tree, thence North seven degrees and thirty
minutes West twenty chains to a stake, thence North eighty-two degrees
and thirty minutes East forty-nine chains to a hemlock tree standing
on the Western side of the Reserved Road aforesaid, and thence along
the same South seven degrees and thence along the same South seven
degrees and thirty minutes East twenty chains to the place of beginning
Containing Ninety-eight acres more or less, and
distinguished as Lot Number Ninety-eight North of Rouchibouque
River;*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits,
commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except
and reserved, nevertheless; out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold
and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *Tract* of Land
and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances (except before excepted), unto the said
Allan McLeod, his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the
Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the
Plan hereunto annexed.

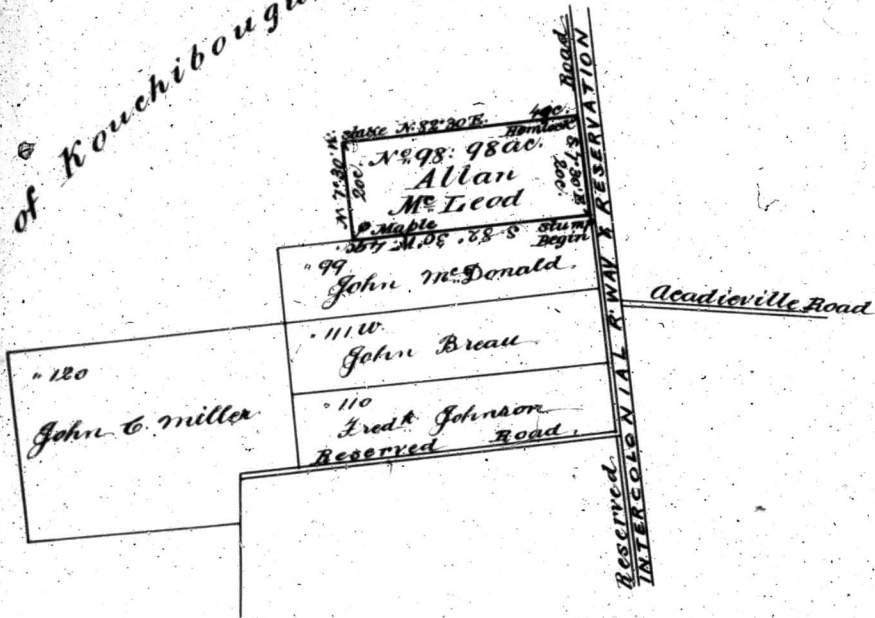
