

# New Brunswick.

Edward VII., by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, etc. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto *The Trustees of School District Number Two,* <sup>their</sup> Heirs and Assigns,

*P. Snowball*

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadieville* in the County of *West* in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit: *Beginning at a stake standing at a point distant <sup>seven chains and fifty links</sup> on the course by the magnet of the year 1903, South thirty-seven degrees East seven chains and fifty links from another stake standing at the <sup>western</sup> angle of lot Number One hundred and eighteen surveyed for *Adem Caron*, <sup>South of the Acadieville Road</sup> hence running by the magnet South thirty-nine degrees and thirty minutes West three chains and seventeen links to another stake standing on the <sup>Eastern</sup> side of the Acadieville Road, thence along the same South fifty degrees and thirty minutes East three chains and seventeen links to another stake, thence North thirty-nine degrees and thirty minutes East three chains and seventeen links to another stake, and thence North fifty degrees and thirty minutes West three chains and seventeen links to the place of beginning.*

*Containing One acre, more or less, and being on the North eastern side of Acadieville Road.*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances (except before excepted,) unto the said *The Trustees of School District Number Two,* <sup>their</sup> Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER. PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

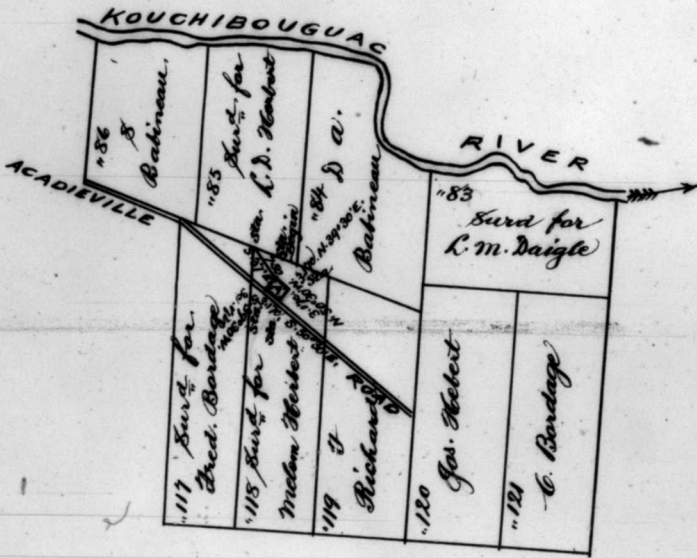
