Edward VII., by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,
King, Defender of the Faith, etc. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

J. A. Snowball KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given
and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

Moelam Herbert, his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Acadieville*

in the County of *Hent* in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a stake, standing at the North-west angle of Lot Number One Hundred and Nineteen, granted to Felix Richard in the Second Tier, South of Nonchibouguac River; thence running by the magnet of the year 1903 South three degrees and thirty minutes West, fifty three chains to a stake; thence North eighty six degrees and thirty minutes West, sixteen chains and thirty five links to another stake; thence North three degrees and thirty minutes East, fifty eight chains and sixteen links to another stake; thence South sixty nine degrees East, seventeen chains to the place of beginning. Excepting all that of the Acadieville Road running through the above described tract, also excepting School Lot, described as follows: Beginning at a stake standing at a point distant seven chains and fifty links, measured on a course by the magnet South thirty seven degrees East, from another stake, standing at the North-east angle of Lot Number One Hundred and Seventeen, granted to Frederick Cordage in the Second Tier, South of Nonchibouguac River; thence from the first aforesaid stake and running South thirty nine degrees and thirty minutes West, three chains and seventeen links to the North-eastern side of the Acadieville Road; thence along the same South fifty degrees and thirty minutes East three chains and seventeen links to another stake; thence North thirty nine degrees and thirty minutes East, three chains and seventeen links to another stake, and thence North fifty degrees and thirty minutes West, three chains and seventeen links to the place of beginning, the said School Lot, containing One Acre, more or less, and the first described tract, containing Eighty eight Acres, more or less, and distinguished as Lot Number One Hundred and Eighteen, in the Second Tier, South of Nonchibouguac River,

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto, belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *Tract* of Land

and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances (except before excepted,) unto the said *Moelam Herbert,* his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.

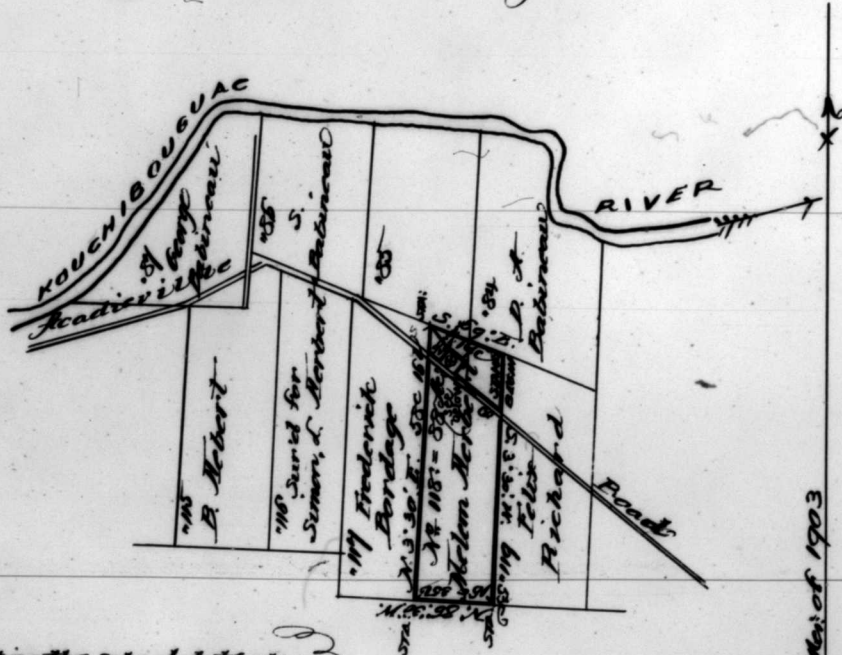
