Edward VII., by the Grace of GOD, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,  
King, Defender of the Faith, etc. To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

*J. P. Snowball*

KNOW YE, That We, of our special grace, certain knowledge, and mere motion, have given  
and granted, and We do, by these Presents for Us, our Heirs and Successors, give and grant unto

*Placide Chasson,* his Heirs and Assigns,

a Tract of Land situate in the Parish of *Rogerville*

in the County of *Northumberland* in our Province

of New Brunswick, and bounded as follows, to-wit: *Beginning at a post, standing on the Western side of the New Mill Road, at the South-east angle of Lot Number One Hundred and Sixty-nine, surveyed for Patrick Chasson, on the West Branch Carnaby River, North-west of Pleasant Ridge Settlement; thence running by the magnet of the year 1901, South <sup>eighty degrees and thirty minutes East</sup> eighty-nine degrees and thirty minutes West, fifty-three chains and fifty links to another post; thence North <sup>eighteen degrees and thirty minutes West</sup> eighteen degrees and thirty minutes West, nineteen chains and eighty-five links to another post, and thence North <sup>eighty-nine degrees and thirty minutes East</sup> eighty-nine degrees and thirty minutes East, fifty-three chains and fifty links to the place of beginning.*

*Containing One Hundred Acres, more or less, and distinguished as Lot Number One Hundred and <sup>sixty</sup> Eight, in the New Mill Road Settlement,*

and also particularly described or marked on the Plot or Plan of Survey hereunto annexed; together with all profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining; except and reserved, nevertheless, out of this present Grant, to Us, our Heirs and Successors, all Coals, and also all Gold and Silver, and other Mines and Minerals; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* of Land and all and singular the Premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances (except before excepted,) unto the said *Placide Chasson,* his Heirs and Assigns, FOR EVER.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this present Grant is upon condition, that the same Grant be Registered in the Secretary's Office of our said Province of New Brunswick, to which Registry shall be attached a duplicate of the Plan hereunto annexed.
