surveyed for Benoit Perry in the Collet Settlement West thence running by the magnet
of the Year 1906, north thirty minutes west sixty seven chains crossing the middle Branch
of Barnaby River in that distance to another post thence north Eighty nine degrees and
thirty minutes east fifteen chains to another post thence south thirty minutes east sixty seven
chains recrossing the Middle Branch of Barnaby River, aforesaid in that distance to
another post standing on the northern side of the Settlement Road aforesaid and thence
along the same south Eighty nine degrees and thirty minutes West fifteen chains
to the place of beginning.
